This equipment has been restored and is in compliance with all known applicable local, state, and federal laws and regulations. ReStored systems and peripherals are disassembled to the base frame. All areas of the main frame, sub assemblies and accessories are scrutinized and categorized prior to under going an exacting cleaning process. Main assemblies and sub assemblies then begin a definitive and documented process that is standard with each ReStored system. Critical parts that have designated life cycles by the original equipment manufacturer (OEM) are replaced 100% of the time, as are parts that show any sign of wear or damage. Exterior panels are either cleaned, painted or in many cases replaced. ReStorage standards and processes are established based upon criteria outlined in OEM product specifications, technical manuals and technical documentation as well as criteria by Underwriters Laboratory, Inc. Sequential inspection methodology has been incorporated throughout the ReStorage process, resulting in multiple functional tests and inspections to ensure quality of the operating mainframe and associated accessories. These procedures were completed in accordance with Adams Remco's ReStorage Process standards. This certificate neither states nor implies any specific warranty.
